The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index fell by 1,065 points week-on-week to 10,070 points, bringing total losses over the past three weeks to 2,141 points. There were sharp weekly drops of \$11,250/day and \$8,250/day in the round-voyage and fronthaul rates (180k dwt) to \$26,750/day and \$50,000/day, respectively.
