### **ALANG, INDIA**

Prices are witnessing a sharp fall at all levels ...

Prices of ship plates is continuously dropping on a weekly basis due to poor demand in the local market. It is currently being traded at USD 346 / MT (Ex-Yard basis) for 8-10 mm thickness. This remarks a 7% drop in it's price from the previous month.

Markets were already witnessing a drop in prices.

Coronavirus is just acting as a catalyst towards further discounting.

The stock market in India behaved likewise the developed markets and has crashed swiping out the money of investors (BSE SENSEX dropped by approx. 6.40% in last 1 month)

This week witnessed an all time high of Rs. 75.59 against 1 USD, conversions were volatile throughout the week but finally settled at Rs. 74 region.

Current time is to wait and watch the market behavior as once the market settles then it's operations will resume in full swing, that would be the ideal most time to book new tonnages for end buyers.

Wait and Watch period may begin ....



Excessive inventory has flooded the market pulling down the prices of ship plates significantly.

Unfortunate breakdown of COVID19 has affected the market conditions.

Imports of containerized HMS has paused.

Prices of importing ships have dropped sharply by USD 15 to 20 opening a window for Pakistani recyclers to place their bids.

Recyclers are currently not ready to book more tonnages on account of excess inventory held at their yards which in the local market is offering lesser prices than anticipated.

### **GADANI, PAKISTAN**


Prices are attracting recyclers to offer their bids ...
