



The SSY Atlantic Capesize Index fell by 1,661 points over the past week to 7,407. The round-voyage rate fell for a third successive week, down some \$8,500/day to \$22,500/day. Meanwhile, at \$35,000/day, the fronthaul rate dropped by \$10,500/day in the past week.

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The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
