

ATLANTICCAPESIZE INDEX

Although up around 7,200 points on the year-ago level, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index has retreated to 10,430, down 3,647 on last month's peak.

The past week has brought further significant downward moves in the Atlantic. The round voyage rate experienced a \$9,250/day weekly drop to \$20,500/day. At the same time the fronthaul rate lost \$6,500/day to stand at \$40,000/day. Both are at their lowest points since early April.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
