### a. UK warship interdicts illicit drugs shipment in Gulf of Oman

A United Kingdom Royal Navy frigate seized 1,041 kilograms of illegal drugs while transiting international waters during a counter-narcotics patrol in the Gulf of Oman. HMS MONTROSE seized 663 kilograms of heroin, 87 kilograms of methamphetamine and 291 kilograms of hashish and marijuana worth a combined U.S. street value estimated at \$26 million.

# c. New force Commander, Commodore João Pereira of the Portuguese Navy commanding the 39th rotation of the Operation Atalanta Force Headquarters gives first impressions on the operations

Commodore João Pereira took command of the 39th rotation of the <u>EU Naval Force</u> Somalia Force Headquarters on flagship ESPS Victoria on Saturday the 15<sup>th</sup>, January 2022. He considered his main goal to be the protection of World Food Programme vessels and other vulnerable shipping, and the contention of piracy and armed robbery at sea, ensuring the freedom of navigation in the area of operations.

Royal Bahraini Naval Ship HAWAR partnered with US Coast Guard Cutters USCGC ROBERT GOLDMAN and USCGC CHARLES MOULTHROPE to conduct communications drills and tactical maneuvers, which increased overall interoperability between coalition militaries to provide coordinated maritime stability in the region.
