



At 9,183 points, the SSY Atlantic Capesize Index has dropped to the lowest point since February, down by 526 points week-on-week. The round-voyage and fronthaul rates fell by \$2,500/day and \$1,500/day to \$15,750/day and \$32,500/day, respectively.

The Atlantic Capesize Index started at 5,000 points on 2 October 1989 and has since been subject to periodic updating to reflect changing trade patterns. The latest update was on 17 July 2015.
