CTF 151 will coordinate an effort of multinational assets, as vessels, aircrafts, unmanned elements and maritime organizations that will work together in an area which encompass some of the world's most important shipping lanes, in order to contribute to the free flow of navigation and use of the high seas, develop capacity for regional leadership and reassure the international community.

1. 42nd Chinese naval escort taskforce starts escort mission

On the morning of October 15 local time, the 41st and 42nd Chinese naval escort taskforces held a handover ceremony in waters of the Gulf of Aden, marking the rotation of their deployments in the Gulf of Aden and the Somali waters.

OCIMF has released the second edition of security measures information paper "Guidelines to Harden Vessels", in order to help operators make an informed decision about security measures for their fleet. The guidelines recommend a layered defence methodology to aid in the mitigation of the risks posed by identified security threats and the new edition has been updated to align with Best Management Practice.

3. Operation Marlin marks an Atalanta first

The European Union (EU) naval task force off East Africa – EU NavFor Atalanta – notched up a first in combined operations recently when it worked with the Regional Maritime Information Fusion Centre (RMIFC/Madagascar) and the Regional Co-ordination Operations Centre (RCOC/Seychelles).

4. U.S. Naval Forces in Middle East interdict \$29 million in illegal drugs

A U.S. Coast Guard fast response cutter seized an estimated \$29 million worth of illicit narcotics from a fishing vessel while patrolling the Gulf of Oman, Oct. 12, two weeks after another sizable interdiction. USCGC Charles Moulthrope (WPC 1141) confiscated 2,980 kilograms of opium and 400 kilograms of methamphetamines as the fishing vessel transited international waters.

5. Piracy attacks drop to lowest levels recorded since 1992

Looking at the first three quarters of this year, the ICC International Maritime Bureau (IMB) has recorded the lowest volume of global piracy and armed robbery incidents since 1992. ICC IMB's latest global quarterly piracy report details 90 incidents of piracy and armed robbery against ships in the first nine months of 2022, the lowest recorded figure in three decades.
