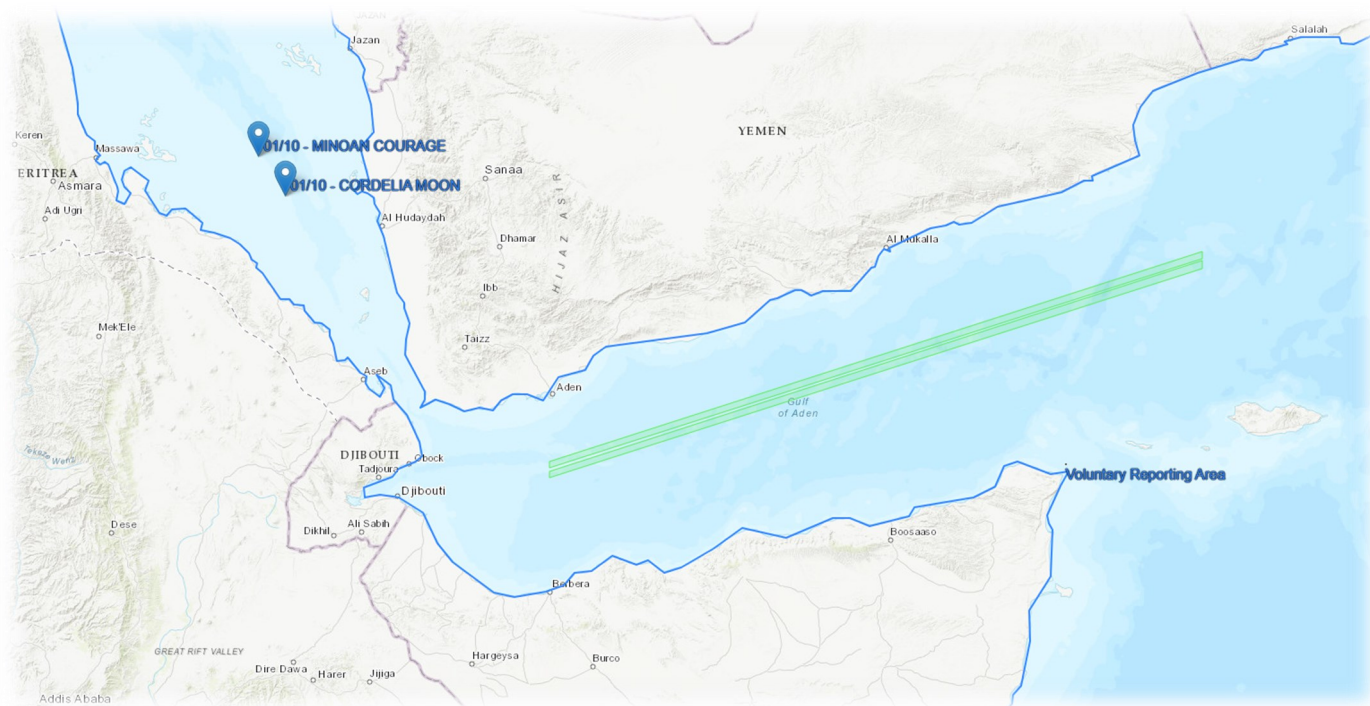




UKMTO Summary Report: 27 September - 4 October 2024

124	Attack	<p>010140UTC Oct 24 - CORDELIA MOON - IMO - 9297888</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> UKMTO received a report from a merchant vessel of multiple attacks, 64 nautical miles north-west of Al Hudaydah, Yemen. The Master of Panama-flagged tanker, CORDELIA MOON reported, that whilst the vessel was in the vicinity of position 15° 08' 28" N - 041° 45' 37" E, the CORDELIA MOON had been subjected to multiple attacks over a period of approximately 3 hours. The first was a report of three splashes by unknown projectiles in close proximity to the port bow of the vessel, followed by a fourth splash from an unknown projectile, circa 100 meters from the aft starboard quarter. Finally the vessel was hit on the port side by an Uncrewed Surface Vessel (USV). At this time CORDELIA MOON did sustain some damage from the USV but did not require any external assistance. All crew were reported safe with no injuries and the CORDELIA MOON continued to its next port of call without further incident being reported. 125	Attack	<p>010415UTC Oct 24 - MINOAN COURAGE - IMO - 9288526</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> UKMTO received a report from merchant vessel CORDELIA MOON of an attack, 97 nautical miles north-west of Al Hudaydah, Yemen. The Master of CORDELIA MOON reported that the Liberian-flagged bulker, MINOAN COURAGE had been hit by an unknown projectile and black smoke had been observed. Shortly afterwards, it was confirmed by the master of MINOAN COURAGE that whilst in position 15^o 37' 00" N - 041^o 26' 00" E, the MINOAN COURAGE had been hit by one missile on the aft starboard quarter. It was reported that the damage had been sustained to the engine of the vessel and that MINOAN COURAGE was drifting to allow the crew to carry out firefighting and to assess the damage. All crew were reported safe with no injuries. The vessel did not require any external assistance and continued to the next port of call without further incident being reported.
