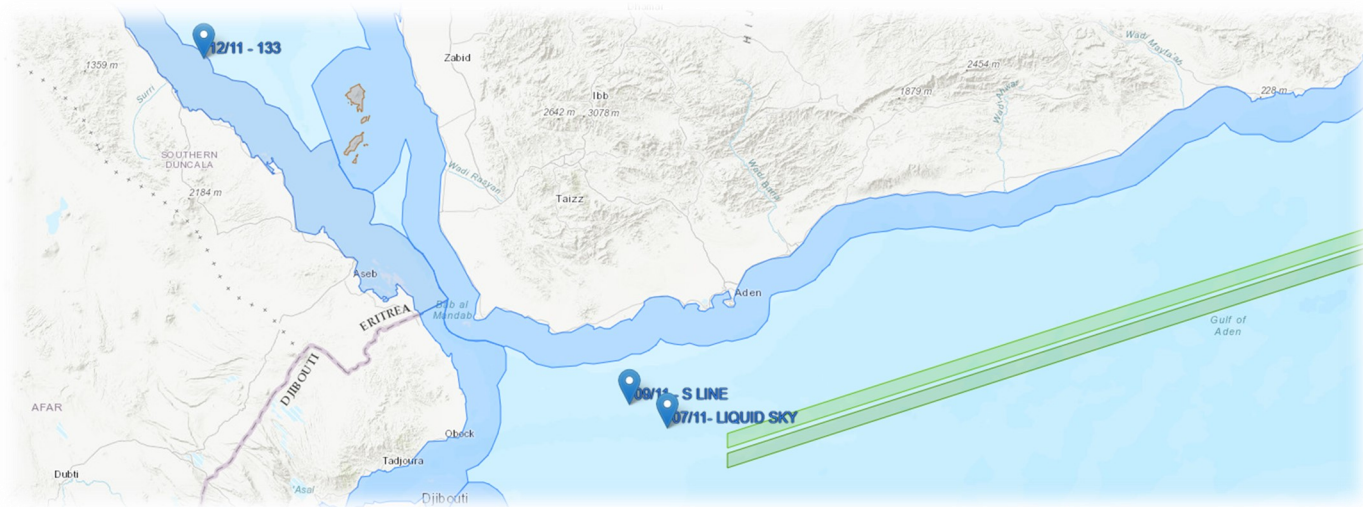

131	Suspicious Approach	<p>070445UTC Nov 24 - LIQUID SKY - IMO - 9794238</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> UKMTO received a report from the Master of motor yacht LIQUID SKY approximately 53 nautical miles south west of Aden, Yemen. The vessel reported being approached within 3-cables by 9-15 small craft, with armed personnel. The Master reported that the crew were all safe and LIQUID SKY continued to the next port of call without further incident. For further details on this incident see: CMF-JMIC InfoNote
132	Irregular Activity	<p>091807UTC Nov 24 - S LINE - IMO - 1080978</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> UKMTO received a report from the Master of Panamanian-flagged bulker M/V S LINE approximately 57 nautical miles south west of Aden, Yemen. The vessel reported being hailed several times over VHF by an entity declaring itself to be a Yemeni authority and warned the vessel to not transit north through Bab al Mandeb or it would be targeted. The vessel turned AIS off and waited for company guidance before proceeding to its next port of call without further incident being reported. 133	Attack	<p>120001UTC Nov 24</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> UKMTO received a report from a merchant vessel approximately 25 nautical miles south west of Al Hudaydah, Yemen. The Master of the vessel reported multiple explosions in the vicinity of the vessel. The Master reported that the vessel had not sustained any damage and that all the crew were safe.
