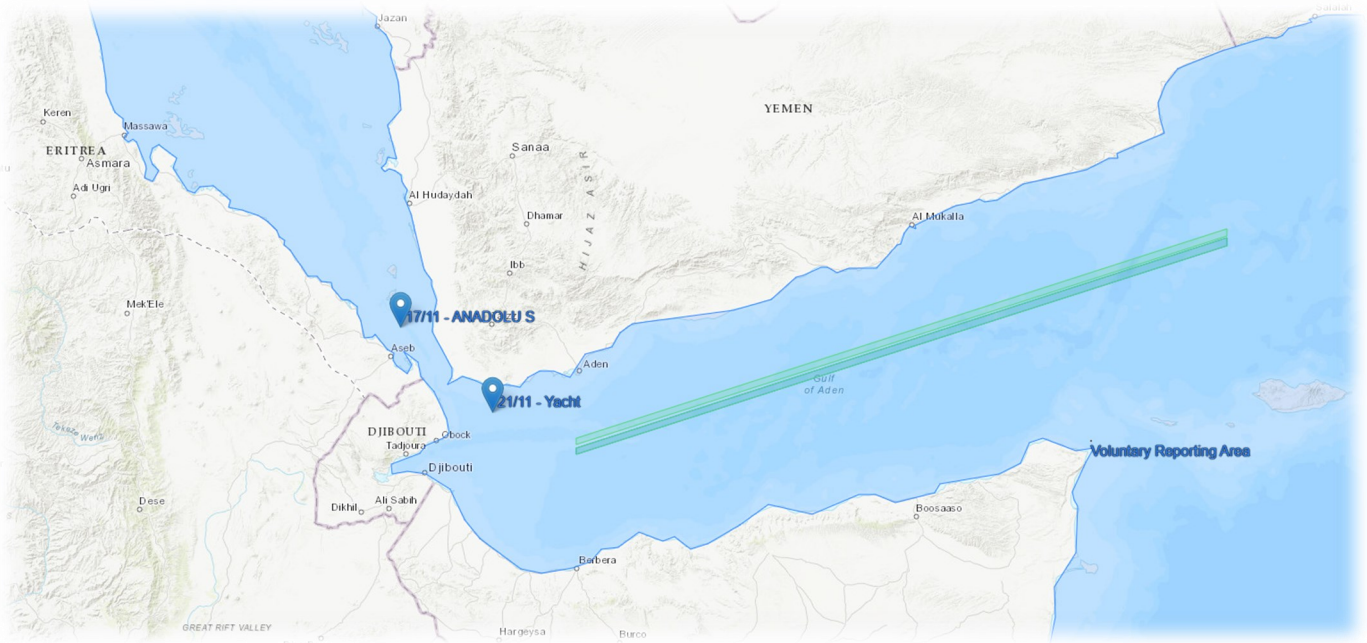




UKMTO Summary Report: 16 - 22 November 2024

134	Attack	<p>171613UTC Nov 24 - ANADOLU S - IMO - 9667758</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> UKMTO received a report from a merchant vessel of an attack, in the vicinity of position 13° 19' 00" N - 042° 50' 00" E, approximately 25 nautical miles west of Al Mukha, Yemen. The Company Security Officer of Panamanian flagged bulker, ANADOLU S reported that initially the vessel had been hailed over the VHF radio by an alleged Yemeni authority and ordered to alter course to the north. The vessel did not comply with the order and continued its transit. Whilst continuing the transit the Company Security Officer of ANADOLU S reported that a missile had splashed in close proximity of the vessel. The impact of the missile had caused the vessel to shake, but on inspection there was no visible damage at that time and the vessel continued to the next port of call. Subsequently, and on 18 November at 0958UTC, approximately 60 nautical miles south east of Aden, the Master of ANADOLU S reported that whilst transiting with AIS on, a missile had splashed in the water in close proximity of the vessel. The vessel was again reported to have no damage at this time and with the crew reported safe also. The ANADOLU S continued to the next port of call without further incident being reported. 135	Suspicious Approach	210330UTC Nov 24 - Unnamed Yacht <ul style="list-style-type: none">UKMTO received a report from the Master of an unnamed yacht, in position 12° 18' 00" N - 043° 58' 00" E, approximately 74 nautical miles south west of Aden, Yemen. The Master of the yacht reported that over the course of a period of 2-hours, up to 12 small craft followed their passage. Despite the yacht conducting evasive manoeuvres, one small craft managed to approach within 1 nautical mile. It is believed the small crafts dispersed and the yacht carried on with its passage to the next port of call, with all crew and vessel reported safe.<i>There is no JMIC info note published for this incident.</i>
